Fr Tony Writes



Last Saturday I had the privilege of participating in the ordination Mass of seven deacons who will go on to be ordained priest next year. Two of them are from our diocese: Gustavo Campanelo (far left) and Eddie Hopkins (next to Gustavo). It is wonderful that we will have two new priests for our diocese in the coming year, but it still remains the case that, "the harvest is great but the labourers are few". But while we certainly must pray for "more labourers" we can be tempted to think that the labourers are just the clergy. In fact we are all called to service in the Lord's harvest, and it is through a culture of understanding our Christian lives as lives of service and self-giving in imitation of Christ that more will respond by giving their lives to God in the ministerial priesthood.



Last week I wrote about the **Eucharist,** and I mentioned that hope to re-introduce communion under both kinds reasonably soon. Following that we had a Pastoral Team

meeting this week, and decided to re-introduce it at weekday masses immediately (as long as there is a Minister of Holy Communion present). To re-introduce it at Sunday Masses we will need to be sure we have enough ministers to have a rota. Some will also need commissioning or recommissioning. Trying to do that over the summer is not really an option, but we hope to start early in the Autumn term.

A reminder that while the chances of passing on infections—especially respiratory infections—through the chalice is very low, nevertheless if you have a cold or other infectious illness please refrain from receiving from the chalice.



On Monday I am going away for my annual retreat. I am off to St Beuno's in North Wales once again. I will, of course, keep the parish in my prayers, and ask you to keep me in your prayers. Fr Paull will be looking after the Masses in my absence.
