We are now in week two of the seven weeks of Eastertide, so plenty more time for celebration!

The Egyptian Coptic Association

Last week I mentioned that the Coptic Orthodox Church will be worshiping regularly at St Theresa's. I asked them to say a bit about themselves and this was what they had to say:

We are a group of Egyptian Christians residing in Brighton and Hove, UK. We are following The Coptic Orthodox Church. Our community gathers to worship and celebrate our faith, and we are eager to contribute positively to the parish and local community. The Coptic Orthodox Church is one of the oldest Christian denominations in the world. It originated in Egypt and is an ancient Christian church that follows the teachings of Jesus Christ and the Apostles. The term "Coptic" comes from the Greek word for "Egyptian", reflecting the Church's roots in Egypt. Coptic Orthodox Christians trace their spiritual heritage back to Saint Mark the Apostle, who brought Christianity to Egypt in the 1st century AD. Our liturgy is conducted primarily in the Coptic language, an ancient Egyptian language with a modified Greek alphabet.

Our purpose:

- 1. Providing spiritual guidance and support through counselling and pastoral care services.
- 2. Offering assistance to those in need through food banks, shelters, and financial aid programs.
- 3. Hosting community events that promote unity, love, and compassion.
- 4. Partnering with local churches and organisations to reach more people with our services.
- 5. Conducting outreach programs to share the message of hope and salvation found in Jesus Christ.
- 6. Organising volunteer opportunities for individuals and groups to serve the communities.
- 7. Advocating for the marginalised and oppressed, following the example of Jesus Christ.
- 8. Promoting holistic development by addressing physical, emotional, and spiritual needs.
- 9. Fostering a culture of generosity and stewardship among our supporters and beneficiaries.
- Striving for excellence and transparency in all our operations to build trust and credibility.

We are currently still finalising arrangements. Once that is done we will publicise the details. But when you see the carpark full in the morning, that is a sign that they are at prayer!
