This weekend we remember and honour those who gave their lives in conflict, particularly in the World Wars of the 20th century. But this does not stop us observing, with Pope Francis, that:

The first victim of every war is "the human family's innate vocation to fraternity". As a result, "every threatening situation breeds mistrust and leads people to withdraw into their own safety zone". Our world is trapped in a strange contradiction: we believe that we can "ensure stability and peace through a false sense of security sustained by a mentality of fear and mistrust" (Fratelli Tutti 26).
