# **Fr Tony Writes**

Congratulations to Hania, Ala, Jonathan, Noah I and Noah F, who are making their First Holy Communion this weekend at St George's, and also to the 18 children, and one adult, who made



their FHC last weekend at St Theresa's. Thanks to all who have helped with the preparation of the children and the FHC Masses.

Receiving Holy Communion deepens our union with Jesus Christ and his Church, and it strengthens us for our mission. All of us are called to discipleship, and one way young people (and others) can live this discipleship is through liturgical ministry. To that end I hope to train up some new altar servers from those who have made their First Holy Communion this year and last year (and indeed anyone else who is eligible). See the box on the opposite page for details.



On Thursday we celebrate the Feast of the Ascension. This is the time when Jesus hands on his mission to his disciples. They ask Jesus what he is going to do, and Jesus says effectively, 'it is your job now', at the same time promising to be with them and send them the Holy Spirit. Let us use the coming final couple of weeks of Eastertide to pray for the gift of the Spirit in our own lives and our own parish, that we truly may be witnesses to Jesus Christ and bearers of his mission.

This leads me on to another theme: A few weeks ago Bishop Richard had a meeting with the pastoral teams and school leaders of the deanery to further explore his Pastoral Plan. This will involve, among other things, working more closely with other parishes. Following on from that, the pastoral teams of the three Hove parishes (ourselves, Sacred Heart, and St Peter's) met together for a very useful 'get to know you' session.

The bishop emphasises in his plan that in order to face the challenges of the future we need a change in mindset. Church is not just something we do, somewhere we go to be fed by Word and Sacrament, or to celebrate important life events. It is something we are: the Body of Christ in the world, bringing the love and mercy of Jesus to our world. You will be hearing a lot more about this, and how we can equip ourselves for the future, in the coming months.
