As you know, I am chaplain to the **Diocesan Walking Pilgrimage** which starts this Saturday in Bristol and ends in Arundel Cathedral, in two weeks time to celebrate the 150th anniversary of the Dedication of the cathedral. You can follow our progress on our website: www.thepilgrims.org.uk You are also welcome to come and join us for a day on the pilgrimage. Details of each day can be found on the website. You might particularly like to **join us on the 'last leg' from Midhurst to Arundel, on Friday 25th August**. We leave Midhurst Methodist Church at 10am that morning. The walk is about 15 miles. You could also **join our celebration Mass at the cathedral at 10am on Saturday 26th August**.

Fr Paul will be celebrating Masses in my absence, though I will be back briefly for the weekend of 19/20 August.

This Tuesday we celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption.



This is a Holy Day, and so there are Masses both in the morning (St George's, 10am) and the evening (St Theresa's, 7:30pm). In this feast we celebrate the fact that Our Lady was received body and soul into heaven at the end of her life. In this way she shares

in a particular way in Jesus' resurrection. We too will share in that resurrection, but only fully at the end of time. But Mary is a sign of hope, for we will follow where she goes.
