Fr Tony Writes

We are coming into a period of celebrations! On Saturday, as a nation, we will be celebrating the coronation of our new King. There will be a Mass to pray for King Charles and our nation, on Friday evening. Then on Sunday we have the first of our First Holy Communion celebrations at St Theresa's, NB. the Mass is at 11am! (there will still be an 11am Mass at St Georges). The following Sunday (14th May) we have our second FHC celebration at St George's (also at 11am).

One of the great joys of being a priest is being able to share in these important moments of peoples lives. And indeed we need priests to lead us in these celebrations, as well as to help us celebrate other events and sacraments.

The 4th Sunday of Easter is often called Good Shepherd Sunday, because the Gospel and the Mass texts refer to Jesus as the Good Shepherd. It is a day when we pray in particular for vocations to the priesthood. We pray that we may have good shepherds in our parishes, to lead us and guide us in our own vocations, especially the vocation of all the baptised: to bring the Gospel into our world.

The Diocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes

Applications from pilgrims requiring assistance to journey with the Diocese Pilgrimage to Lourdes this summer are back to pre-Covid numbers – which is wonderful news, but it does mean we now need lots of helpers, nurses and HCA's to apply to make sure we have

enough people to care for them in Lourdes.

"Being a helper is an act of service that many of us do not get to offer during our day to day lives. Giving our time and care for a week in Lourdes can make such a positive impact on the life and wellbeing of the people we help, and ourselves. There are many ways that you can help someone, the first step is to apply!". Further information and a link to the application is available on the Lourdes Pilgrimage (abdiocese.org.uk) website.

The diocesan pilgrimage to Lourdes takes place 28th July to 3rd August for those travelling by air, or 27th July to 4th August for those travelling by coach or jumbulance. The cost for Helpers and Clinicians is £680 (subsidised) or £850 full price. There are further subsidies which may be available. Thank you, The Pilgrimage Office.

The parish may be able to offer a contribution towards the helpers cost also. Please speak to Fr Tony. Deadline to apply is by the end of April.
