Fr Tony Writes:



And however our Lenten preparations have gone, we are all invited to participate in the remembrance of the events at the heart of our Faith. Today we are invited to accompany Jesus into Jerusalem. But the Passion reading reminds us how things quickly turned sour (from a human perspective).



On Thursday we will join Jesus in the Upper Room as his disciples, and then watch with him in Gethsemane. On Friday we will be at the foot of the Cross on Golgotha, and then follow him to the tomb. Then on Saturday night we will be at that same tomb, hearing the announcement that "He is Risen", and marvelling at what has happened!

Remembering is at the heart of our worship. The Mass is our ongoing response to the Lord's invitation "do this in memory of me". But our remembering is not a mere recollection of something that happened long ago. In the remembering, those events become present. Above all we do this in the Mass, for the Lord becomes truly present, and so we are all in a sense in the Upper Room, at the foot of the Cross, and at the empty tomb every time we celebrate Mass. Every time we celebrate the Mass and the other sacraments we celebrate what we call the 'Paschal Mystery': the events of Holy Week and Easter. And in doing so we participate in them.

So I invite you to enter deeply in to this Mystery by coming to as many of the Holy Week services as you are able. Your time will be well spent!
