## **Fr Tony Writes**

Welcome to a new term and a new academic year! And as in the parish much of what we do is linked in to the academic year, I guess it is a new parish year too!

So what have we got to look forward too? These are the usual things such as preparation for and celebration of the Sacraments, and details about these will be forthcoming in the next week or two. In a few weeks time we will be welcoming the new intake at St Mary's. St Mary's will also be celebrating their Advent service at St Theresa's. Then in the In the new year we will have our Mass for the Sick, and our Mass to celebrate Wedding Anniversaries. And of course there are all the usual seasons and feasts!

But the coming year will also bring us new things, and perhaps some new challenges. In order to be equipped for the future we will need a more generous response to God's call to us to be disciples. Most notably this will involve parishioners taking more responsibility for things that currently are done by the clergy, but which actually are the responsibility of all the community. It will also likely mean a certain amount of rationalisation; in our case working much more closely with the other parishes on this side of the deanery (St Peter's, Sacred Heart, and St Mary Magdalen's).

The shape of this is by no means determined yet, but we cannot just continue on as we are, gradually stretching those who are exercising leadership more and more thinly until they snap!

This actually requires a deeper appreciation of our Christian faith and calling. So I invite all of you to participate in the faith formation programme 'Sycamore', which begins at the end of the month. I appreciate it is a significant commitment, especially for those with young families. But it will be worthwhile! I shall be going on about this *ad nauseam* for the rest of the month!!

Another new thing, or rather a restoration of something we used to do, will be the return of Communion under both kinds. This will require some training and commissioning of ministers, both those who have been ministers before and new recruits. Watch this space!

But all this must begin with prayer and be rooted in prayer. So I am inviting everyone to deepen their life of prayer. I will be introducing a few tools to help with this in the coming weeks.

Despite the challenges, we must look forward to the future with hope. For to quote St Paul:

We know that by turning everything to their good, God co-operates with all those who love him (Rom 5:28)
