# **Fr Tony Writes**

After seven full weeks we have reached the end of Eastertide, and we go out with a bang-or rather wind and fire-with the feast of Pentecost.



John Armstrong's painting of Pentecost at St George's, to which I referred in last week's homily, has lots of detail. He says of the painting:

"Mary. Standing at the centre, tells the disciples to go out and preach her son.

The Gospels have not yet been written but Mark, at the right, begins to make notes

The Holy Spirit showers energy, flames and wind as the disciples get up from where they were setting and stride out with confidence and obedience.

James has made a cross from sticks that were used earlier as barricades.

Peter holds up the keys to preach the kingdom. They go down to the people who have not yet heard the message."

There are other symbols in the painting too—see if you can spot them. Everything in the picture has some sort of meaning!

As we are considering discipleship, can I encourage you to go to the Discipleship Mass at Sacred Heart on Thursday at 7pm. One of the purposes of this is to come together to pray for our deanery and to help support each other in bringing the Gospel to Brighton and Hove (and Southwick!). Sometimes we, like the disciples before Pentecost, barricade ourselves in somewhat. This is the first of a series of Masses in the deanery, which will move around the churches. These Masses will help encourage us to look beyond our own walls.

I won't be there myself unfortunately, because I am away on a short break with my family this coming week. Fr Paul will be celebrating the Masses. I will be back on Tuesday 6th June.
